Thought For The Week:

"Come and See"

This invitation is repeated twice in today's Gospel reading. The first time it is Jesus inviting the disciples shuffling behind him to come and see where he is staying. They do, and they spend the rest of the day listening and learning. The second time it is Philip inviting his friend Nathanael to come and see a person Philip believed could be the Messiah foretold by the prophets. Nathanael, although skeptical anyone worth listening to could come from the small town of Nazareth, does, and is amazed to find out Jesus already knows all about him.

A simple invitation, "Come and see," when accepted, can lead to great things. What might Jesus be inviting you to come and see? Who can you invite to come and see Jesus?
