### Thought For The Week:

Today's reading from the Gospel of John tells the story of Jesus' encounter with a woman we know of only as, "the woman at the well." Much is made of the fact that this woman has had five husbands and theories about her history range from scandalous to tragic. What often gets overlooked is the deep theological conversation this woman has with Jesus, and the fact Jesus takes the time to speak with her and answer her questions and wonderings. Jesus sees this woman as more than her history, as Jesus sees all of us as well. While our lives, our histories, and our actions are important to Jesus, what is also important is our willingness to engage with him in the here and now and to hear what he has to say. The woman at the well ended her encounter with Jesus by running to tell others about him. What will your encounter with Jesus today prompt you to do?
