Thought For The Week:

Transfiguration Sunday

Today is the last Sunday in the Season after Epiphany, which traditionally is Transfiguration Sunday. Transfigure means to change one's appearance, in particular a change that serves to glorify. Although we won't hear the traditional Transfiguration story of Jesus on the mountain-top, we will hear a story of a blind man given his sight. This life-changing event, as Jesus himself says in the gospel reading, is one that gives glory to God. Transfiguration Sunday serves as a bridge between the season of Epiphany, where we hear of the spread of the light of Christ, and the season of Lent, which takes us into the gathering darkness as Jesus approaches the cross. As we enter into the holy season of Lent, may we, like the man born blind, be made able to truly see Jesus, the one whose life, death, and resurrection were intended to bring hope and salvation to all.
