Today's Gospel reading recounts the story of Mary anointing Jesus' feet with a fragrant - and expensive - perfume. Judas, one of Jesus' disciples, interprets this act as wasteful and is quick to criticize what she does. Jesus interprets it as an act of worship and a preparation for his burial to come. One wonders how Mary felt having her heartfelt gesture first dismissed and then praised. Too often, we are quick to judge the motives and actions of others, forgetting that there may be much more to the story than we see on the surface. May we strive to respond to one another with the same compassion Jesus had toward the woman and her extravagant gift, recognizing that what we see doesn't always tell the whole story.
