Kerry Marcks & family for Georgie, Kerry's aunt, for healing.

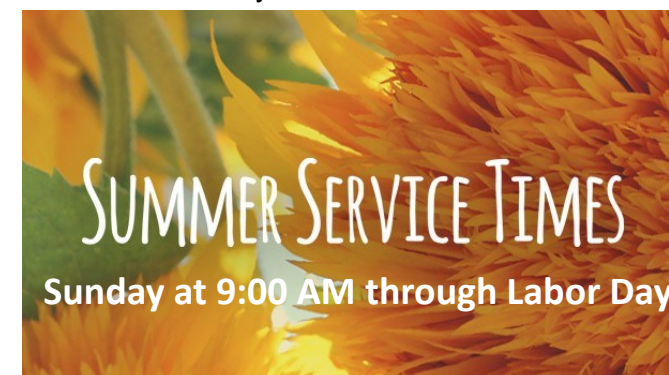

Thought For The Week:

The Ascension

This past Thursday, May 30, was the official Day of Ascension in the Christian church, although we are observing/celebrating it today. Why does such an important church celebration happen on a Thursday? The Feast of the Ascension, as it is known, is always celebrated forty days after Easter. This is because the book of Acts reports that Jesus appeared among his disciples during the forty days following his resurrection. On the fortieth day, Jesus gathered them together, promised them they would be his witnesses to the ends of the earth, and then ascended into heaven. Jesus also told the disciples to wait for the "power from on high" to come to them – this hinted at the coming of the Holy Spirit, which we will celebrate on June 9, the Day of Pentecost!

Please plan to stay for **refreshments and fellowship** following worship.

Christus is equipped with **hearing-assistance devices**. If you would like a device, please see an usher.
